The Solent Language Hub offers free CPD opportunities for all teachers in Portsmouth. These in-person sessions, with an option for virtual follow-up later in the term, bring educators together to explore strategies for enhancing principled practice and evidence-based pedagogy. Focusing on motivation and foundational knowledge, the training provides a well-rounded balance of theory and practical application tailored to language teachers.
